

Terms of Service

Terms and Conditions Applicable to Contracted Projects

1. Legally Binding Agreement:

By signing a contract with Blue Collar Pressure Wash, you are signing a legally binding contract for work to be completed at an agreed upon price. In the event that you break this contract, all deposits made to the company shall be surrendered as damages.

2. Product Warranties:

All warranties are limited to those offered by the manufacturers of the products used. Blue Collar Pressure Wash makes no additional warranties. If you ever have a concern regarding our work, Blue Collar Pressure Wash should be notified immediately.

3. Water Usage:

By signing this agreement, you agree to provide Blue Collar Pressure Wash the right to use an on-site water supply as needed to complete the stated project without compensation. If an exterior water supply is required, it will be at an additional charge. It is the customer's responsibility to make sure the water supply is on and in working order before we arrive. Additional charges will be applied if water is not available.

4. Electrical Usage:

By signing this agreement, you agree to provide Blue Collar Pressure Wash the right to use an on-site source of electricity as needed to complete the stated project without compensation.

5. Color & Tone Concerns:

The properties and species of wood, age, and weather can greatly affect the resulting color or tone of stain. Note: Variances may occur on individual boards as well as total project as densities and other characteristics vary across and throughout the wood. Blue Collar Pressure Wash and its associates attempt to represent final finish color and tones as close as possible. While we can often give you an idea of the overall color or tone you must expect some variance in the overall finish.

6. Courtesy:

While Blue Collar Pressure Wash is on location and performing work on your property, you are responsible for keeping all children and pets, as well as other individuals away from the work area. Work surface needs to remain undisturbed for at least 24 hours after our work is completed. This is for your safety as well as our own.

7. Payments:

payments made to Blue Collar Pressure Wash are due as per the contract schedule and are to be paid by check, cash, or card. All balances are ALWAYS due upon completion of the job. Any change to this policy must be agreed upon and in writing on our contract. Late charges will immediately be assessed on all balances not paid in accordance with contract terms. The customer agrees to pay any collection cost incurred by Blue Collar Pressure Wash related to the collection process of outstanding balances.

8. Scheduling:

We try our best to keep scheduling conflicts to a minimum, however, inclement weather is beyond our control. You will be notified of any changes

9. Removal & Replacement of Contents:

Removal and replacement of grills, deck furniture, planters and any other items are the responsibility of the homeowner. Should we need to remove items, we will not be responsible for any damage, breakage or for storage issues. An additional charge may be applied for time and labor devoted to the removal of these items.

10. Damages:

Blue Collar Pressure Wash is not responsible for damages due to improperly installed siding, loose shingles or siding, broken or opened windows, improperly sealed windows and doors, wood rot, defective construction, improperly secured wires, loose or improperly installed gutters and leaders, or improper caulking. In every aluminum siding case and in some cases with vinyl siding, the sun and weather will bleach the color or cause fading. Power washing, which entails removal of chalky, gritty or failing surface materials may cause the faded aspects of the vinyl or aluminum to stand out. Blue Collar Pressure Wash will not be responsible for such conditions. Blue Collar Pressure Wash will not be responsible for loose mortar that may dislodge during the cleaning process.

11. Stains:

Some stains cannot be removed by power washing. Tree sap, artillery fungus, splatters from stains and paints are examples of materials that cannot be removed by conventional means. We make every attempt to point these areas out to the customer when quoting the project. Sometimes these stains cannot be removed at all.

Blue Collar Pressure Wash expects your property to be in good repair and weathertight. This includes, but is not limited to all electrical fixtures including receptacles and lights. Doors and windows shall also be weathertight. Blue Collar Pressure Wash is not responsible for damages as a result of water infiltration from poor or improper installation, maintenance or repair of electrical related items or doors and windows. Blue Collar Pressure Wash cannot guarantee removal of artillery fungus from exterior house surfaces. (if applicable)

Windows may become water spotted as a result of services. Window cleaning is not included in our service.
